Part-B

1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

- ❖ To provide education to educationally, socially and economically backward and underprivileged rural women students. There has been a steady raise in students' strength from 2607 to 2856. Among the students, 60 percent are first generation college learners and 52 percent are from rural areas and 5 students are differently abled.
- ❖ To promote academic excellence through updated curriculum and innovative teaching - within a span of five years of autonomy the syllabus has been revised four times. Apart from core subjects, Non Major electives, Skill based electives, Value Education, Environmental studies are included in the curriculum. ICT enabled teaching aids such as LCD projectors, Interactive Board, Star Board, Visualiser etc are added and training was given to the faculty on the usage of aids in teaching.
- ❖ To promote value based education - certificate and diploma course in Gandhian Thought was made mandatory for the first and second year students respectively to inculcate Gandhian principles in the minds of youngsters.
- ❖ To promote social values, students are encouraged to participate through National Service Scheme, Youth Red Cross, Consumer club, Red Ribbon Club etc
- ❖ To preserve cultural values among the students celebrations such as Pongal, Pooja, candle Lighting ceremony, Youth Talenta are organized.
- ❖ To provide opportunities for self development, job oriented courses, Spoken English, Computer training, Personality development courses, Entry-In-Service programme, SET/NET coaching are conducted for the overall development of the students.

2. New academic programmes initiated (UG and PG)

3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction

- Three core electives, Six skill based electives and two non major electives are offered to the students by each department. Curriculum designed is learner centered
- Computer based papers are included in the curriculum of all the departments
- Spoken English component is included in Part II English for all the students
- Main focus is made to Indian writers in the curriculum of English literature
- To enrich the vocabulary of the student a “Learn-a-word- a- day” has been displayed
- Dictionary and encyclopedia in the lectern outside the department of English enables easy reference to all
- Computerized accounting is included in the commerce curriculum and every student from commerce department goes out with tally knowledge

- The Department of Mathematics introduced UGC sponsored add-on course on “Operation Research” which has an extensive application in industrial sector
- MATH Lab is established to learn and explore the concepts and theorems using technologies
- Under skill based electives, quantitative aptitude, general knowledge, job seeking skills were included, which enable the students to face competitive examinations.
- For the benefit of the women’s students, Health, Hygiene and child care are included in the curriculum of Zoology
- Display of science facts on the notice board to create awareness and enrich the knowledge of science
- Animation technique has been included in the curriculum of computer science which has a wide application in the media
- Awareness on traditional Medicinal Herbs is included in Tamil curriculum
- Feedback on curriculum from outgoing students is collected and is used in revision of the syllabus.

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started

- ❖ Every department is offering Non Major Elective papers to all the First year students. The students are at liberty to choose any two papers among the various electives offered.

5. Examinations reforms implemented

The main objective of this programme is to prepare SC/ST/OBC and minority students for appearing in NET or SET. Various delegates, Lecturers, Academic experts of reputed institution were invited and coaching was given on coding, decoding, research aptitudes, higher education, mathematical ability and logical reasoning. During this programme the syllabus of the NET for the post of Lectureship was covered by the trainers. Forty candidates attended and equipped themselves.
