- 1. To prepare AQAR and submit it to NAAC.
- 2. To train staff and students for NAAC Peer Team visit.
- 3. To organize orientation and faculty development program for the benefit of staff.
- 4. To collect feedback from stakeholders –students parents and alumni.
- 5. To enhance ICT enabled Teaching and learning process.
- 6. To revise the curriculum of all UG and PG courses.
- 7. To motivate staff to publish books and present papers in national and International conferences.
- 8. To increase the number of participants in the cultural programmes.
- 9. To apply for the introduction of more PG courses.
- 10. To introduce M.Phil courses in English.
- 11. To introduce Award System for the teachers based on Academic Performance Index (API) score.
- 12. To introduce the number of working days from 90 days to 100 days in every semester.
- 13. To conduct three Internal assessment tests instead of two tests.
- 14. To implement the UGC guidelines limiting the Grace period of two years after the minimum period of gestation for UG and PG courses.
