WORKSHOP ON BETTER VISION IS OUR RESPONSIBILITY

E.M.G. Yadava Women's College Placement cell organized a one-day workshop titled "Better Vision is Our Responsibility" in collaboration with Maxi Vision Eye Hospital, Madurai. The workshop aimed to raise awareness about eye health, preventive measures, and the importance of regular eye care.

Objectives:

1. To educate participants about common eye disorders, their causes, and preventive care strategies.
2. To emphasize the significance of regular eye check-ups and adopting a healthy lifestyle for better vision.
3. To encourage students to take proactive responsibility for their eye health and spread awareness in their communities.

Programme Highlights:
