Faculty Exchange Program Details

Faculty member Mrs.K. **Gowsalya**, Assistant Professor of Nutrition & Dietetics from EMGYWC delivered lectures on topic “Enzyme”. Students and faculty members had the opportunity to engage in Lecture demonstrated on enzyme activity, inhibition, and the effects of environmental factors on enzyme function. The sessions was beneficial in reinforcing theoretical concepts and providing real-world applications of enzyme studies. The exchange program facilitated the revision and enhancement of the biochemistry and biotechnology curricula at both institutions.
