





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This Memorandum of Understanding is to be executed at Madurai on by the Chief functionaries of the parties.

Whereas EMG Yadava Women's College is a government aided institution established in 1974 by the founder and patron E.M.Gopalakrishna Kone with more than 45 years of experience in the field of education and women empowerment. EMGYWC have been involved in enhancing the status of women folk as students, teachers, entrepreneurs and professional academicians, educationist imparting quality education to all by promoting alternative education. It plays significant role in emphasizing the importance of Women's Rights, Right to Education and Life Skills, through women-friendly responsive colleges in Tamil Nadu.

And whereas the TNTEU is an exclusive University for Teacher Education established by the Government of Tamil Nadu (Act No.33 of 2008) to promote excellence in Teacher Education, in the year 2008. This University is unique in nature relatively to the other Universities since its assignment is to promote excellence in teacher education and produce dynamic and smart teachers for the benefit of the society and the nation at large, with six Departments of Study and Research viz., The Department of Pedagogical Sciences, Department of Value Education, Department of Educational Psychology, Department of Educational Technology, Department of Curriculum Planning and Evaluation and Department of Educational Planning and Administration. TNTEU produces M.Ed., M.Phil., and Ph.D. scholars every year through the University Departments as well as through 716 affiliated Colleges of Education in Tamil Nadu www.tnteu.ac.in

# Purpose and Objectives:

The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and interaction towards the empowerment of women / students through the prevailing educational institutions in Tamil Nadu. Hence, the parties desire to work together with the following objectives:

- 1.1. To promote women-friendly responsive colleges in Tamil Nadu by organizing training, seminars and workshops for Teaching and engage working staff, parents and other related stakeholders.
- 1.2. To do research and field analysis.
- 1.3. To encourage and emphasize the teaching staff to participate and contribute as resource faculty in students' programmes.
- 1.4. To encourage teacher education students for field exposure to Friendly Responsive Colleges and interact with the students as part of their extracurricular activities during the studies.
- 1.5. To conduct and organize regular training and seminars at regular intervals with a view to promote and produce friendly women students in Tamil Nadu.
- 1.6. To share and exchange a common concern for the development of higher education and pursuit of academic excellence in higher education.
- 1.7. To consider the valuable works of the TNTEU and EMGYWC for promotion of qualitative and equal education to all.
- 1.8. To strengthen the educational relationships between the TNTEU and EMGYWC for the welfare of needy and downtrodden community through institutional association with special reference to women.

#### 2. Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- 2.1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Vice-Chancellor of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the Management of the Institution of EMG Yadava the part of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University under any circumstances.
- 2.2. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such

renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the parties/Institutions.

23. That the programme of activities for the period of cooperation with specific project outlines and arrangements as may be agreed upon by the parties will be the subject of a series of separate documents. However there shall not be absolutely any financial commitment on the part of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, under any circumstances.

### General:

The broad general areas of cooperation envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding will include:

- 3.1. Participation of staff of the two Institutions and the students supported by the Institutions in both Undergraduate & Post-graduate programmes of study conducted in TNTEU and Field exposure conducted by EMGYWC as would be appropriate, with no financial commitments on the part of the University.
- 3.2. Development of faculties whereby students of the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University and the Institution of EMGYWC would be facilitated to complete their study courses/parts of their study courses by the Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, India. as per the norms and standards of National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE).
- 3.3. The focus on off-site short training programmes and field-based studies organized by EMGYWC, on behalf of TNTEU would be appropriate.
- 3.4. Exchange of staff and students including research scholars between the two Institutions on collaborative teaching, research and other academic assignments in accordance with their respective mission.
- 3.5. Participation in each other academic/social community activities like seminars, conferences, workshops, library exchanges, language programmes and so on in curriculum planning and evaluation, educational psychology and value education, pedagogical sciences, educational technology and educational planning and administration.

- 3.6. Facilitating for educational tour to the staff and students of TNTEU to EMGYWC project area on regular basis would be appropriate.
- 3.7. Guidance, advice and training of Staff Development and Career Guidance of Students and other stakeholders.
- 3.8. Sharing of information and facilities in support of the above collaborative activities.
- 3.9. The parties will support the activities under this Memorandum of Understanding to be carried out within its premises and will arrange the programme and facilitate the visit of the staff from the other Institutions participating in joint activities.
- 4. Facilities: The authorities of both parties will support the activities to be carried out under this Memorandum of Understanding by providing necessary facilities.
- 5. The Memorandum of Understanding will come into operation on the date of signing of this Memorandum and operate for three years in the first instance subject to a mid-term review after one year, and an end-of-term review after five years. It may be extended or terminated by mutual consent.
- 6. The TNTEU and EMGYWC agree that this Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual agreement and that each institution may unilaterally withdraw after six months' notice to the partner.
- 7. The functionaries shall meet at least once in three months for planning and
- 8. The University shall not have any sort of financial commitment and sharing of any infrastructural facilities in respect of any of the activities envisaged in the MOU.
- 9. It is done subject to the approval of the Syndicate of TNTEU
